Literacy

Our story this week is The Gingerbread Man.

Discuss where the story is set, when it was set and who are the characters.



Phonics

Our Read Write Inc. sounds for this week are:
x, ng and nk

We have now learnt all of the RWI Set 1 sounds! Take time to review all of the sounds, focusing on any that your child is not yet confident with.

Communication and Language

Extend children's vocabulary, explaining unfamiliar words and concepts through stories.

Examples from 'The Gruffalo' include: 'stroll', 'roasted', 'knobbly', 'wart' and 'feast'.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We are focusing on the feeling sad this week.

In Maths this week, our focus is one more. We will continue working with numbers up to five.

Practice with objects: count how many you have to start with, add one more, how many do you have now? How do you know? Can you show me the jump on a number line?
