We recognise the importance of promoting healthy lifestyles in school and want our pupils to develop an increasing understanding of the many different factors that contribute to keeping healthy. In addition, we want our pupils to have a developing understanding of how to maintain good mental health and wellbeing. Our curriculum, therefore, teaches an understanding of emotions, promotes resilience, and encourages an open approach to discussing worries or concerns. 
