This week has been a busy week and even the cold weather hasn't stopped us from taking our learning outside!



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Attendance expectations

What YOU must do:

Try to telephone the school before 8.30 am each day of your child's absence.



Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.

Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour, or friend.

If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance, then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What We will do:

Check your child's attendance every day. Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.
Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.
If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.

If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival. Or you can check on our website: Is my child too ill for school? - Caister Primary Federation
