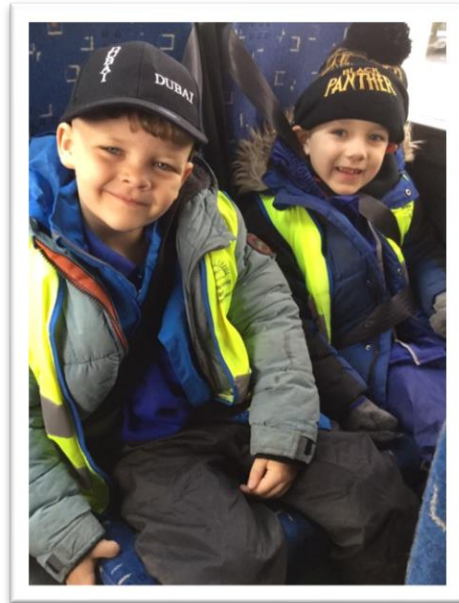


To all our families,
