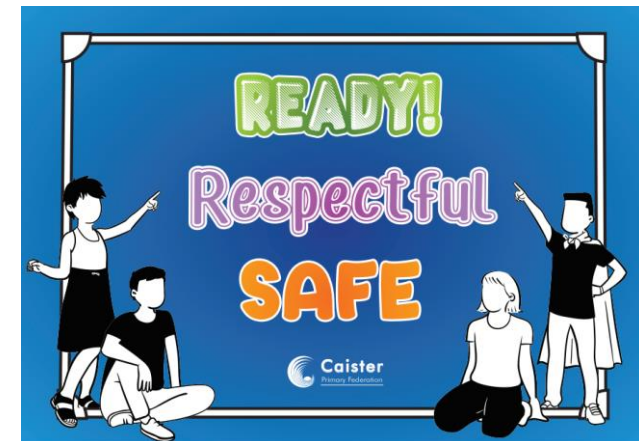
Welcome back to the Summer term, I hope you all had a good break. I have enjoyed going around and seeing lots of children working hard and catching up with friends with big happy smiles.

A severe and often sudden allergic reaction is called **anaphylaxis**, which can progress into a life-threatening reaction within minutes. Administration of an adrenaline auto-injector pen (AAI) can be lifesaving.

We've partnered with Kitt Medical's Anaphylaxis Kitt service to add a further safeguarding measure in school so that, in the unfortunate event of a serious reaction, we can provide life-saving medication to anyone. Our Kitt is stored centrally in school in a secure location.

All staff in school are trained to use this Kitt if a child or adult develops anaphylaxis, and this will be administered if the need arises. If you would like to discuss this further or have any concerns, please contact Myself or Miss Moss.

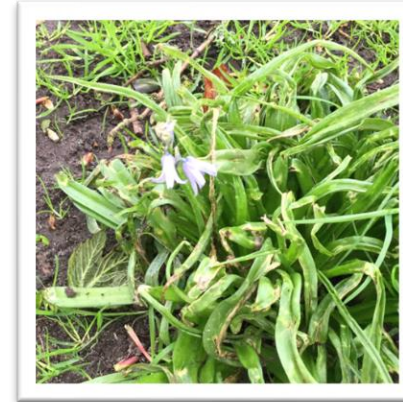

To avoid a parking fine, please remember parking is restricted along Kinston Avenue.

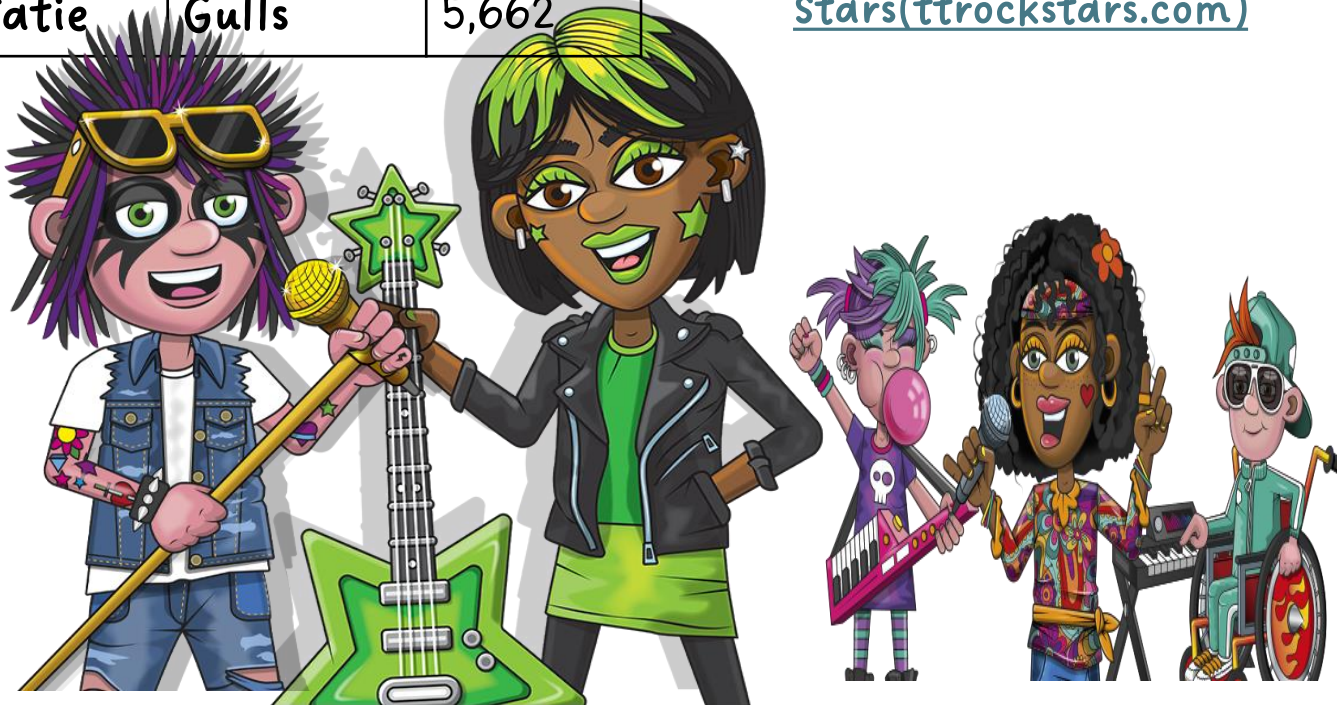
