Pupils should

1. Know about and understand a range of religions and non religious world views by learning to see these through theological, philosophical and human/social science lenses.
2. Express ideas and insights about the nature, significance and impact of religious and non-religious worldviews through a multi – disciplinary approach.
3. To gain and deploy skills rooted in theology, philosophy and the human/social sciences engaging critically with religious and non-religious worldviews.

Pupils should be taught an in depth investigation of:

- Christianity
- Two other Principal religions

And encountering at least one other religion or world view.
