

## **Proposed significant changes to schools; establish special educational needs (SEN) provision**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that, Norfolk County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to the following schools, in accordance with section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013.

- Caister Infant & Nursery (Community) School and Caister Junior (Community) School, Kingston Avenue, Caister on Sea, Great Yarmouth NR6 6QA – prescribed change is to establish a 16 place Social, Emotional and Mental Health Specialist Resource Base, located on the school site.
- Drake Primary (Community) School, Fairfields, Thetford IP24 1JW – prescribed change is to establish a 16 place Autistic Spectrum Disorder Specialist Resource Base, located on the school site.
- Hillcrest Primary (Community) School, Hillcrest, Downham Market, PE38 9ND – prescribed change is to establish a 16 place Learning and Cognition Needs Specialist Resource Base, located on the school site.
- Mundesley Infant (Community) School and Mundesley Junior (Community) School, Trunch Road, Mundesley NR11 8LE – prescribed change is to alter the 10 place Social, Emotional and Mental Health Specialist Resource Base at Mundesley Infant School to establish a 16 place Social, Emotional and Mental Health Resource Base, located on the school site.
- Redcastle Family (Community) School, St Martins Way, Thetford IP24 3PU – prescribed change is to establish a 16 place Autistic Spectrum Disorder Specialist Resource Base, located on the school site.

These proposals will be implemented from 1 September 2020.
