All clubs are cancelled Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> December due to the disco.





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## Ask me about.....

### Year 3

Maths	We have looked at the 3,4- and 8- times table this week and used a range of methods and resources to multiply and divide these.

Science	We learnt about the skeleton, and we looked in detail at bones and how they are constructed.

History	We looked at Cheddar Man, the oldest complete skeleton found in Cheddar Gorge who was from the Stone Age.
Computing	We used word documents to make lists using numbers and bullet points of our favourite things.
