

Attendance expectations

What **YOU** must do: Try to telephone the school before 8.30 am each day of your child's absence.

Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters. If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival. Or you can check on our website: Is my child too ill for school? – <u>Caister Primary</u> <u>Federation</u> Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour, or friend. If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance, then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What We will do:

Check your child's attendance every day. Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you. Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned. If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.



Drop off and pick up.

Thank you to everyone for working with us at drop off and pick up times. Please could we remind everyone that parents/carers should not come beyond the school gate at the junior school or beyond the corner at Penguins class if you are dropping off via the infant school. Please could you share this information with grandparents and other carers who may pick up or drop off. Thank you.
